e-Audiobooks on EBSCOHost - PCs, Laptops & Macs

Requirements

- Create an EBSCOHost Account. Go to the following webpage:
 - http://bit.ly/1IeyDVt
 - (you may be asked or your library card number and PIN)
 - Then click **Sign In** at the top of the screen and **Create New Account**
- Download an audio player. This can be Windows Media Player or iTunes

Searching for e-books

- 1. Go to Barrie Public Library website:
 - http://library.barrie.ca
 - Search for your audiobook in the online catalogue.
 - You may filter search results to show only **EAudio** in the **Refine by** menu on the left of the results page
- 2. EBSCOHost e-audiobooks have the following link under the title:
 - → NetLibrary A downloadable audio book accessible through the World Wide Web; click for information
- 3. Click this link to go to the e-audiobook on the EBSCOHost website

Checking out and downloading

- From the e-audiobook record on the EBSCOHost website, you can click Sample to listen to an excerpt or Download to save a copy to your computer
- You may be prompted to sign in, using your EBSCOHost account details
- 3. You can choose the loan period (1- 21 days)

- Then click on Checkout & Download. You
 may be prompted to install EBSCO Download
 Manager. This is required to download eaudiobook files from EBSCOHost
- The e-audiobook will download and should open up in your preferred audio player.
 The audiobook itself is usually stored in the same folder as other music files.

Managing your EBSCOHost eaudiobooks

- When signed in to the EBSCOHost Audiobook Collection website you can click on My Checkouts, in the top right corner, to view your e-audiobooks
- Once you have downloaded an e-audiobook you can copy it to a mobile device in the normal way for your preferred audio player. Click on the Help menu in your audio player for assistance
- EBSCOHost e-audiobooks cannot be returned early
