
Libraries on the Go/OverDrive eBooks – Kobo Aura One

Getting started

- 1. Connect the Kobo Aura One e-reader to the internet using WiFi
- 2. From the Home screen, tap the ••• icon in the upper-right corner.
- 3. Go to Settings > OverDrive.
- 4. Tap Get started.



- 5. Select Create account or Sign in to OverDrive.
- 6. Find your library on the **Find a public library** page. Tap your library's name to sign in.
- 7. Follow the prompts to create an OverDrive account, or you can sign in with your library card or an existing OverDrive account.
- 8. If prompted, select **Sign in** to add your library card to your account.

Searching for ebooks

- Search for title or author using the search box at the top of your Kobo's Home screen or go to Top Picks and view the Libraries on the Go section
- 2. Once you have done a search, restrict your results

to library e-books only by opening the **Show** menu and select **OverDrive**



Checking out and downloading

- From the search results list you can tap Borrow next to a title to check it out
- If you are viewing the details page of an e-book, tap
 the ··· icon and select either Borrow with
 OverDrive or Place Hold with OverDrive.
 You may be asked for your library card and PIN
- The e-book should automatically download to your Kobo if it is available

Managing your OverDrive e-books

- OverDrive ebooks checked out to you can be managed in your **Books** screen
 Tap the book cover to open and read it.
 Tap and hold to organize, remove or return it early to the library.
 - Tap ••• and select **List View** to see the expiry date for your library e-books
 On the Home screen, tap **Sync** to download available e-book holds and books checked out by other means
- The Request again option (in the book actions menu) will let you borrow the eBook again immediately after its lending period expires or place you on the title's wait list.
- OverDrive ebooks can also be managed on the Libraries on the Go website. You can change your default lending period (7, 14 or 21 days)
- If you already have an Adobe ID you can use this to authorize your Kobo in Settings > Accounts.
